“Ripe, rich and concentrated, with lovely raspberry, dark plum and cassis flavors. Fine-grained tannins, with luscious spice notes. Balanced and structured, with a lilting finish of ganache and thyme. Mourvèdre, Syrah and Grenache.

Drink now through 2011.”
